Part of Anchorage Youth Court's mission is to educate youth about our justice system. We do this through community outreach, lectures, mock trials, new member classes, and the Law & Leadership program.

In September we had the opportunity to attend Gruening Middle School and present mock hearings to 270 eighth graders. Our open house was a week later with 75 people attending a mock hearing put on by AYC members.

We are proud to say this year we have increased our youth engagement through our new member classes by 40 percent. By year end, just over 100 youth will have taken AYC's new member class.

In addition to our classes taught by dedicated volunteers, AYC's curriculum has been integrated into legal studies classes at Mears, Goldenview, and Clark middle schools. Upon completion of the legal studies course, students are then able to take the bar exam and be sworn in to begin their journey as an AYC volunteer.




