PALMER, ALASKA – On February 15, 2023, a section of the roof at the Palmer City Library collapsed causing extensive damage. “This catastrophic collapse of the Palmer Library roof greatly impacts my city and the entire Greater Palmer Area. Our team is diligently examining the damage to determine next steps.” stated Mayor Steve Carrington.

Currently, the structure is being assessed for safety and we will have more information about recovery in 24-48 hours.
