## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA EO No. 2024-1(S)

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FINANCIAL RESOURCES FOR LABOR, SUPPLIES, AND OTHER EXPENDITURES REQUIRED TO ADDRESS MUNICIPAL RESPONSE TO THE COLD WEATHER SHELTERING CIVIL EMERGENCY [AVALANCHE] BY: APPROPRIATING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000) FROM THE AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101000) TO A FUND TO BE DETERMINED BY THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER; APPROVING A TEMPORARY EXCEPTION TO THE UNRESERVED FUND BALANCE DESIGNATION POLICY FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE.

**WHEREAS,** on January 25, 2024, the Municipality of Anchorage began to experience sustained sub-zero temperatures, with the extended forecast projecting these conditions to last for the foreseeable future; and

**WHEREAS**, at the onset of these extreme cold weather conditions, the Administration lacked the necessary resources to provide adequate shelter and care to vulnerable populations within the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2024, pursuant to authority granted in Article V, Section 5.02 of the Home Rule Charter for the Municipality of Anchorage and AMC 3.80.040, the Mayor declared that a civil emergency existed within the Municipality of Anchorage based upon the events and circumstances specified above ("Cold Weather Sheltering Civil Emergency"); and

**WHEREAS**, the Anchorage Home Rule Charter, Article X, Section 10.03, provides that, in case of an emergency as defined in Charter § 17.13(c), "an ordinance may be introduced and adopted at the same meeting," provided the Assembly makes a finding in the emergency ordinance that an emergency exists and provides a statement of the facts constituting the emergency; and

WHEREAS, Charter § 17.13(c) states that "Emergency' means an unforeseen occurrence or condition which results or apparently will result in an insufficiency of services or facilities substantial enough to endanger the public health, safety or welfare"; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to AMC 12.25.040B.5., if necessary, taxes required to fund the cost of an emergency ordinance enacted pursuant to Charter Section 10.03 are excluded from the tax increase limitation otherwise imposed by Charter Section 14.03 and AMC Chapter 12.25, allowing for the recovery of any costs without curtailment by the tax increase limitation; now, therefore,

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

**Section 1.** Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Charter Section 10.03, the Assembly hereby specifically finds that the sustained period of the sub-zero

Weather Sheltering Civil Emergency.

Section 2. The funds appropriated and authorized by this Emergency Ordinance shall be collected in 2024 pursuant to Charter § 14.03(b)(5). The sum of not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) is hereby reappropriated from the Areawide General Fund (101000) to the [A] fund, or funds, that [AS DETERMINED BY] the Chief Financial Officer determines will best enable to the Municipality to effectuate the acquisitions and expenditures anticipated in Section 1, and thereby most effectively respond to the Cold

temperatures constitutes a civil emergency within the Municipality of Anchorage.

The Assembly further finds that (1) such emergency now requires immediate

appropriation of funds for labor, supplies and other expenditures to address the critical efforts by the Municipality to preserve and protect the public safety, health

and welfare from extreme cold weather, including but not limited to expansion of Municipal facilities used for sheltering or warming services, and the acquisition of

supplies, equipment, services, personnel, fuel, or food in support thereof; and (2) a

failure to immediately address these issues will result in an insufficiency of services

<u>Section 3.</u> The Assembly hereby approves a temporary exception to the unreserved fund balance policy of the Municipality of Anchorage, permitting the Municipality to conclude the 2024 fiscal year with less than the unrestricted fund balances dictated by AR 2015-084 in light of the emergency circumstances outlined in this ordinance[, THROUGH STATE AND FEDERAL ASSISTANCE OR TAX REVENUE].

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly and remain in effect for sixty (60) days pursuant to Charter § 10.03, unless sooner repealed by the Assembly.
