Hello Mark,

Thank you for your email. **Removal of a Mayor by 2/3rds is Already the Law, established by the Charter.** The 1975 Charter establishes the rule that the Assembly can remove a mayor for breach of the public trust by 2/3rds vote. That rule is not created by AO 2022-060(S), and it will continue to be in place whether AO 2022-60(S) passes or not.

AO 2022-060 is not an effort to remove the current Mayor, it is about establishing procedures and a process for removing elected officials including a mayor, as there currently are for other elected officials like Assembly members and School Board members.
