Executive Proclamation *by* *Governor Sean Parnell*

Under the authority of Article II, Section 9 and Article II, Section 17 of the Alaska Constitution, and in the public interest, I call the Twenty-Seventh Legislature of the State of Alaska into its first special session at Juneau, Alaska, in the legislative chambers on April 18, 2011, at 1:00 p.m., to consider the passage of bills on subjects germane to the titles of the following bills while those bills were under consideration by the Senate and House of Representatives during the first regular session:

HB 108 – Appropriations for the Operating and Loan Program Expenses of State Government

HB 109 – Mental Health Appropriations

SB 46 – Capital Appropriations and Appropriations to Capitalize Funds

SB 76 – Supplemental Appropriations

HB 104 – Alaska Performance Scholarship Fund

SB 42 – Power Project: Susitna/Alaska Energy Authority

HB 106 – Extend the Alaska Coastal Management Program

SB 84 – Vocational Education and Basic Funding/Tax Credits

HB 24 – Extend the Regulatory Commission of Alaska

HB 126 – Extend Boards and Commissions
